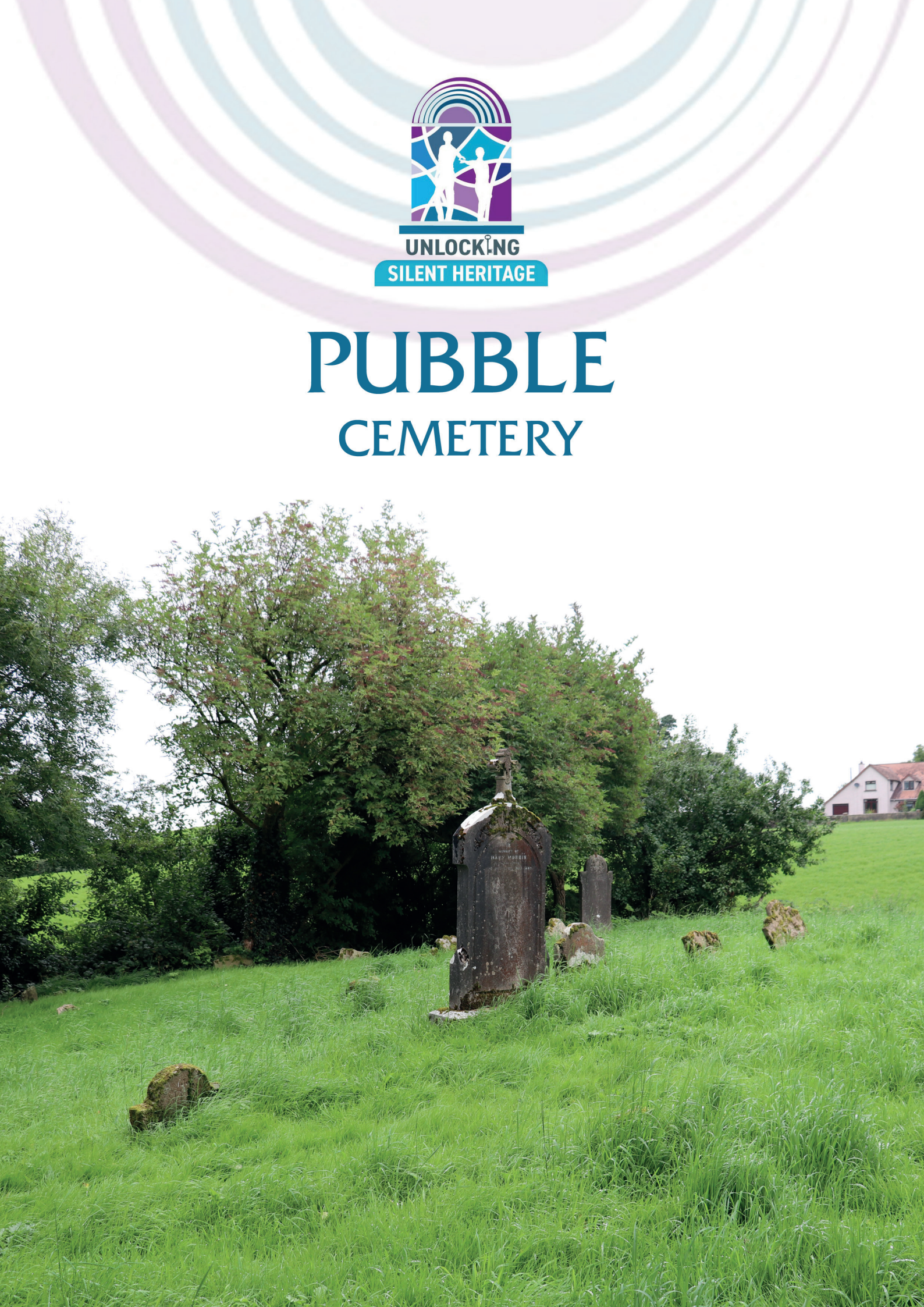


Pubble Cemetery, Newtownstewart, County Tyrone

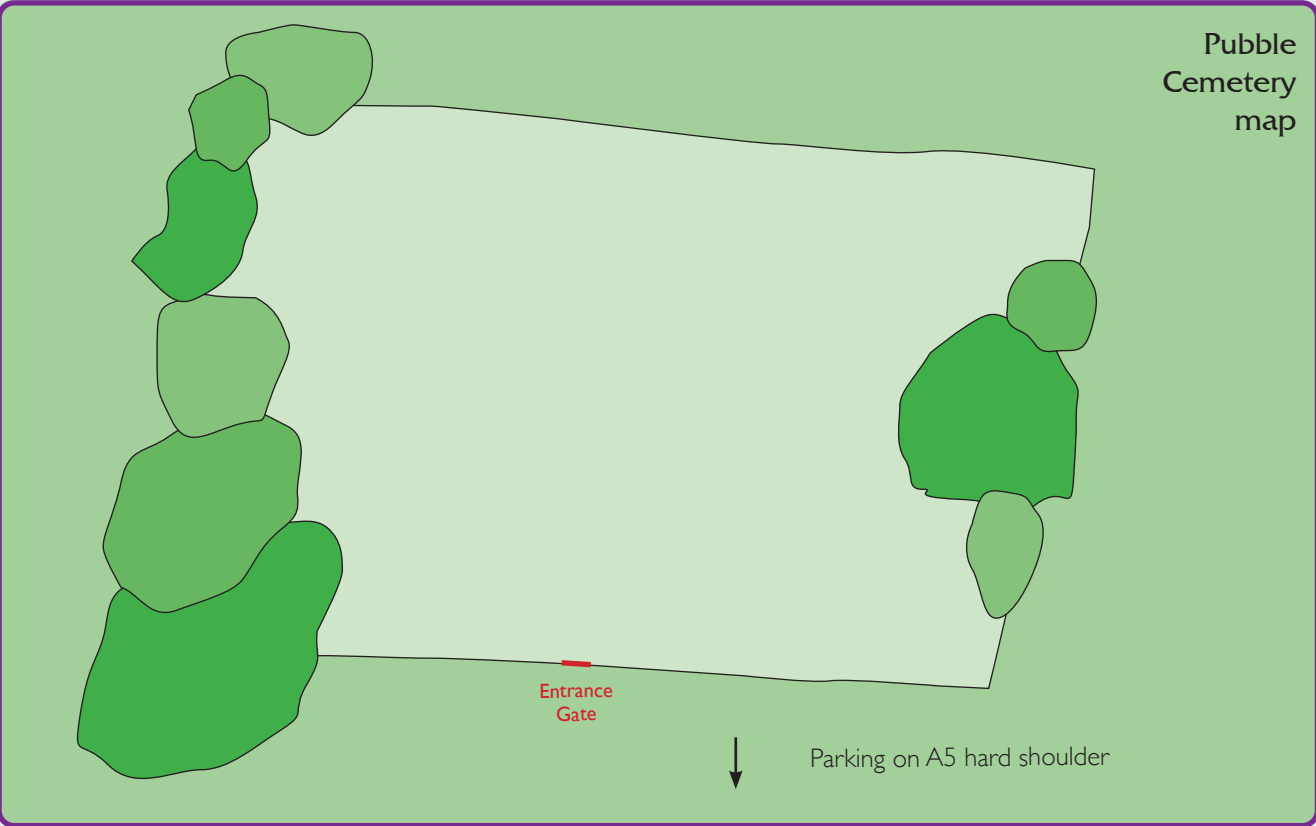
